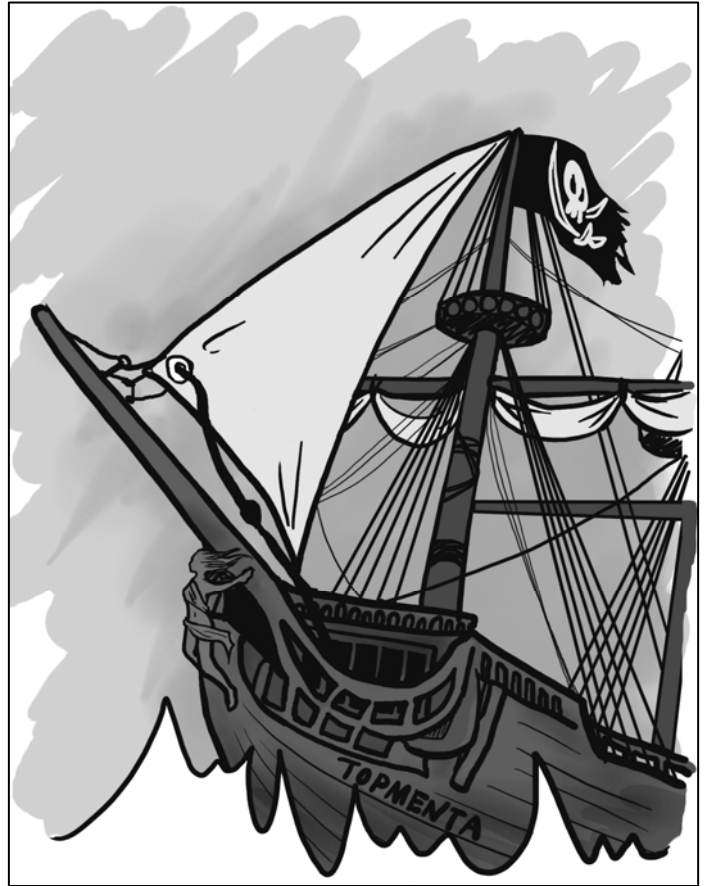
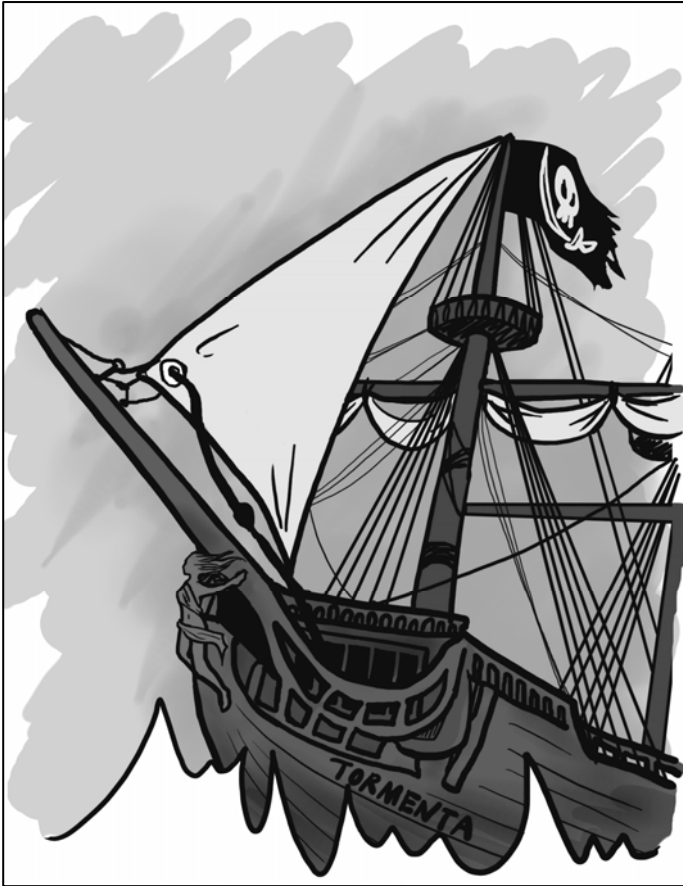


## Spot The Difference
